Entry requirements

- High School diploma
 - Abitur/Fachabitur with final exam in English
 - International or European Baccalaureat
- Pass for mathematics
- Motivation letter
- 2 recommendation letters
- Selection interview

Application deadline: 1 June



Student facilities

- Lots of space for private study and group work
- Copy & campus shop
- Bike repair shop
- Restaurants and Cafés
- Sports facilities: gyms, fitness rooms, football halls, swimming pool, climbing wall, dojo
- Student counselors, psychologists, pastoral care



Costs

- Tuition fee EU: €2209, first year 50% discount
- Accommodation: €350 – 550
- Living costs: €300 – 500
- Total €10,000 – 15,000 / year

- Global Project and Change Management: guaranteed housing in student residence in year 1 (360 euro per month)
